Outdoor Sheltering in Kelowna

Overnight Sheltering Site (890 Baillie Ave)

The City has designated a public space for outdoor overnight sheltering until more space is available in emergency shelters or housing.

- Permitted areas for shelter set-up are clearly marked and available **5:00pm–9:00am**.
- **Onsite storage** is available **8:00am–6:00pm** for camping supplies and other large items.
- Campers must abide by all posted guidelines.

Guidelines

- Shelters must be temporary and separated by at least 5 feet.
- Shelters in and around the designated site are not permitted from **9:00am–5:00pm**.
- Cooking and smoking inside tents or structures is prohibited.

Metro Drop-In (1262 St Paul St)

New Day-Use Site location

The Metro Drop-In is a space where you can access washrooms, light breakfast and lunch, a place to be for the day, and Metro Onsite storage. The Café and courtyard are open for drop-in Sunday to Friday **9:00am–4:00pm**.
